Dear Scheduler for Secretary Becerra,

My name is Sharon Kramer. I reside in California. Secretary Becerra knows who I am.

I am a nationally recognized environmental health marketing and health policy reformer.

Secretary Becerra's and my paths first crossed when he was California Attorney General in February of 2017.

I asked him to investigate a corruption problem involving collusive abuse of HHS and the California courts.

While being video recorded Secretary Becerra said:

"If you'll allow me to interject for Ms. Kramer sake, that the department of justice is there, available. If she has some matter that she would like to bring to the attention of my office, we'll certainly consider that. We always will. We always should."

Unfortunately, he did not follow through on the above pledge as a state attorney general. As a result, as HHS Secretary, he is now serving as the steward of the ongoing corruption problem that he pledged to investigate six years ago.

It is a delicate matter involving medico-legal disinformation originating from HHS. It has many political implications going back to the first year that George Bush, Jr. was POTUS.

I am able to see that the problem is becoming worse under Secretary Becerra's watch; and it is posing a national security threat.

Since April of 2023, I have sent eleven emails to the General Counsel of HHS, Mr. Bagenstos, and the receptionist of OGC.

I have made eight phone calls requesting that Mr. Bagenstos reply and that he relay the information that I am sending to Secretary Becerra. Thus far, I have not received the courtesy of a reply from Mr. Bagenstos.

As such, I am requesting a zoom meeting with Secretary Becerra and Counselor Bagenstos at their earliest convenience.

It should not take more than twenty minutes to explain the ongoing corruption problem; and to begin a dialog of the actions needed to rectify the matter in the best interests of the people, science, justice, and the future of HHS.

Please send my best to Secretary Becerra. I am of the opinion that he did not understand what a massive medico-legal crime that he pledged to investigate when he said the above quoted words to me.
